FINAL CALL FOR ENTRIES – TRAVEL PHOTOGRAPHER OF THE YEAR 2024 New international exhibitions to showcase the latest winners in Bolivia, China, UAE and UK

Entries for the 2024 international Travel Photographer of the Year competition (TPOTY) close on 6th October, so amateur and professional photographers of all ages and from all countries have less than four weeks left to submit their images to this global contest, which celebrates its 22nd award this year. As well as £10,000 in cash plus other prizes, the winning entrants will see their work showcased in international exhibitions in the UAE, UK and - soon to be confirmed - China next year.

TPOTY 2024 has a range of categories, reflecting the breadth and diversity of travel photography, and entrants will be competing not only for a fine selection of prizes but also for the international exposure and acclaim that comes from achieving success in the awards. Already confirmed for 2024 and 2025 are Travel Photographer of the Year exhibitions at Foto Festival Manzana 1 in Bolivia (20 - 24 November 2024), Xposure Festival of Photography in Sharjah, UAE (20 - 26 February 2025) and Banbury Museum & Gallery in Banbury, Oxfordshire, UK (29 March - 6 July 2025)... with more to come! There will also be an exhibition of past winners at Foto International Festival Manzana 1 in Bolivia this November.

Submissions must be made online at www.tpoty.com, and entries close on 6th October. Entry fees are amongst the lowest for any international competition, starting at £12, with FREE entry to Young Travel Photographer of the Year.

With <u>support</u> from Radiant Imaging Labs, The Photocloser, SheClicks, Genesis Imaging, Eye for the Light, and the Royal Photographic Society, the awards offer some excellent prizes include cash bursaries, portfolio reviews by a New York photographers' agent, magnificent prints, photo tuition, Lensbaby kit and membership of the Royal Photographic Society.

In addition, the winners receive a huge amount of international media exposure for their work plus further exposure through the TPOTY exhibitions.

Prospective entrants looking for inspiration can find it in the past winners' galleries on the TPOTY website.

The awards are judged by an <u>international panel of imaging experts</u>, who give their time and expertise freely to judge the awards. This year TPOTY welcomes a new judge to the panel, the internationally acclaimed, multi award-winning nature and wildlife photographer Ellie Rothnie.

Since Travel Photographer of the Year was founded in 2003, entries have been received from more than 155 countries, and more than 50 nationalities are represented amongst the category winners. Overall winners have come from Bangladesh, Belgium, Canada, Italy, Malaysia, the Netherlands, Portugal, Russia, Spain, Slovenia, the UK and USA.
